This year we have started with spiritual matters. We have reached 99 people including pastors i know you will wonder how we have reached pastors! Late January thus 26-28 we had a mission to Butere/mumias District where we had door to door visits as we camped there. We discovered that the so called pastors didn't even have Bibles. There was one pastor who had about a forty page thing, and he called it a bible...bless him. Another one said has pastured his church for fifteen years with a new testament Bible and only two members of his church has the same. Some ministers bear footed and torn T-shirts; Last day in that mission; the Lord spoke to me to tell them that we meet next in Kakamega Rush. owe back and arranged to bring them over. It took us another three weeks to organise Thank God, will always prepare 'table in the wilderness's 78:19.

A man from Australia came during that period and visited RUSH. We explained what we saw and experienced at Butere/Mumias. He willingly provided funds to bring the Pastors/ Evangelists over - Praise God. He was the main speaker in that conference of five days; even at the end we issued Bibles to some people and certificates. The theme was 'PERFECTION' we could not manage to give all people but we gave 1 each church.

Actually we saw the hand of God, we gave out shoes to those who were bear footed and even clothes and fed them for all those days. Isn't God a amazing! RUSH – Walking the talk. We didn't just give shoes, clothe from only our pockets but as we had involved pastors in Kakamega we had to teach about giving in a different format that is 1 John 3:16 and so many people we touched and gave cheerfully. The

end of conference we were all looking the same- physically and spiritually. Q: How many bibles do you have in your house?

Besides, we realised that most of them had never seen a tarmac road or even electricity. So we had to show the film of Jesus and the passion Christ and we believe they enjoyed the exposure. One of the five days we had a tour. We visited one of the town churches for them to learn more. These are some of the remarks from them:

1. Jotham Lunani 'I have never been happy in the whole of my life like to day'.
2. George Sakwa 'So there is such great joy in the Lord?'
3. Lillian Mukonyi 'Now I believe'
4. Clara Andayi 'organise another one please'

There were so many remarks, glowing faces and we believe the hearts too. We know we have not given enough bibles so if God touches you, here bibles cost 6 pounds and believe me that is a great gift for those people in Butere/mumias. They really want to know God and hear him more. Lastly about the conference many people were delivered, they came as curses but left as blessings. But really about seven Pastors needs bicycles for they walk long distance to their assigned churches about 10 miles one way. Cost of the bicycle is 60 pounds.

On behalf of RUSH, we just want to say you are very special people to us and thank you for being part of this project. Reaching Unreached is not easy, we need each other. It's our prayer that the Lord sustains you gives good health, happy life, peace and success in all you do. Was just about to forget last but not least, since we began RUSH in Kakamega is when a local church has supported us financially with a cheque of 84 pounds to RUSH-Don't you think God is timely!? Praise God.

In all we cheerfully welcome you to come and see what the Lord is doing through you. Be blessed. We need your prayers most, for it can help the local people to see the need of helping each other.

Something to remember-don't waste your pain, use it to help others. This has given me a good focus.
