It's our prayer that the choir get another uniform since the other one is old and also some funds to enable the choir transport, food and accommodation for National competition. The orphanage is almost through just remaining few things to finish up, we thank God for Joan, Pastor Paul, all members of Whyteleafe Free church and other friends for there continue support for RUSH project, God bless you more abundantly. Due to busy schedule, we could not be able to celebrate RUSH anniversary. But God willing we are planning to celebrate the 5th RUSH anniversary on 11 November this year and also we are planning RUSH conference immediately after the anniversary, the conference will be facilitated by Pastor Ed and his team who will be arriving in Kakamega on 6 November for ten days . Tailoring school is doing well with 20 girls on board. 10 girls will be doing there government trade test 3 this year Praise God. Carpentry school is also doing well. Most of the boys now know how to make different types of furniture's we thank God for everything.
