RUSH (Reaching the Unreached Self Help) is a charitable project devoted to provide practical training, primary education, medical assistance and housing for AIDS/HIV widows and orphans in Kakamega, Kenya.

## News from Andrew & Lucy in Kakamega (part 3 of 3)

**Y**outh programme: This is a programme that has grown rapidly, youth meet every Thursday for teachings on HIV/AIDS and reproductive health, and they are over 50 members. As you all know HIV/AIDS is the killer disease in Africa. We teach our youth awareness, home based care, protection measure and advocacy. Kenya adults infected with HIV 6.7%, women aged 15-19 years which are infected 3%, and men aged 15-19 years which are infected 0.5%. Among women 20-24 years is over 4 times that of men in the same age group 9% vs. 2%. The peak prevalence among women is at age 25-29 years {13%} which prevalence rises gradually with among men to peak at age 40-44 {9%}. Only in the 45-49 years age group is HIV prevalence among 5% higher than that among women 4%. Tuberculosis is strongly associated with HIV infections and AIDS with more than half of TB patients in Kenya infected with HIV, so trends of TB reflect the overall prevalence of HIV in a region. The number of adults living with HIV/AIDS 1.25 million. The number of children living with HIV/AIDS 120,000. New infections adult are 86,000 and children new infections 30,000. We thank ALL friends from UK for your continue support and ALL who came to Kakamega to support RUSH God bless you all and meet the desires of your hearts and bless the work of your hands.
