

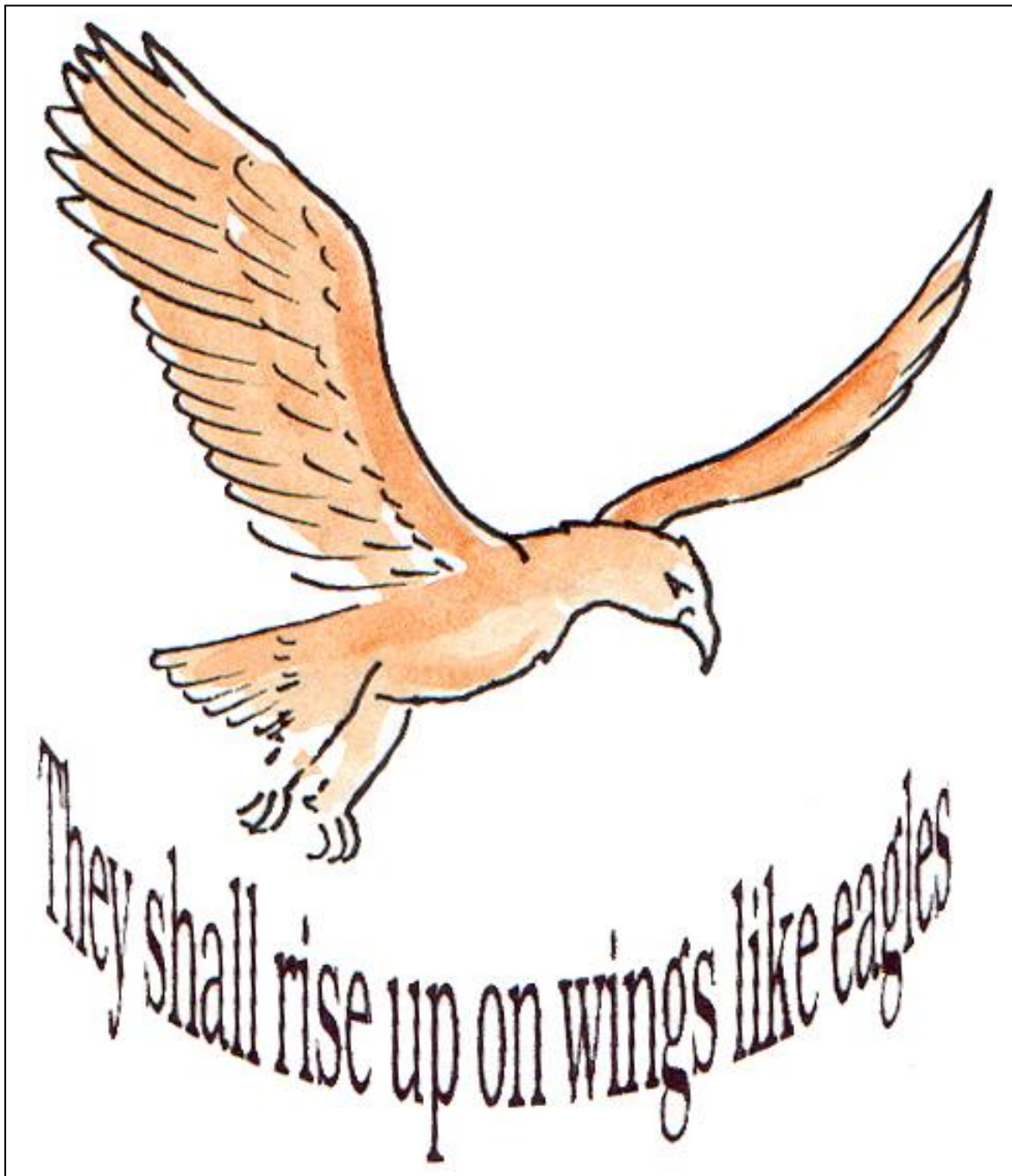
# Whyteleafe Free Church

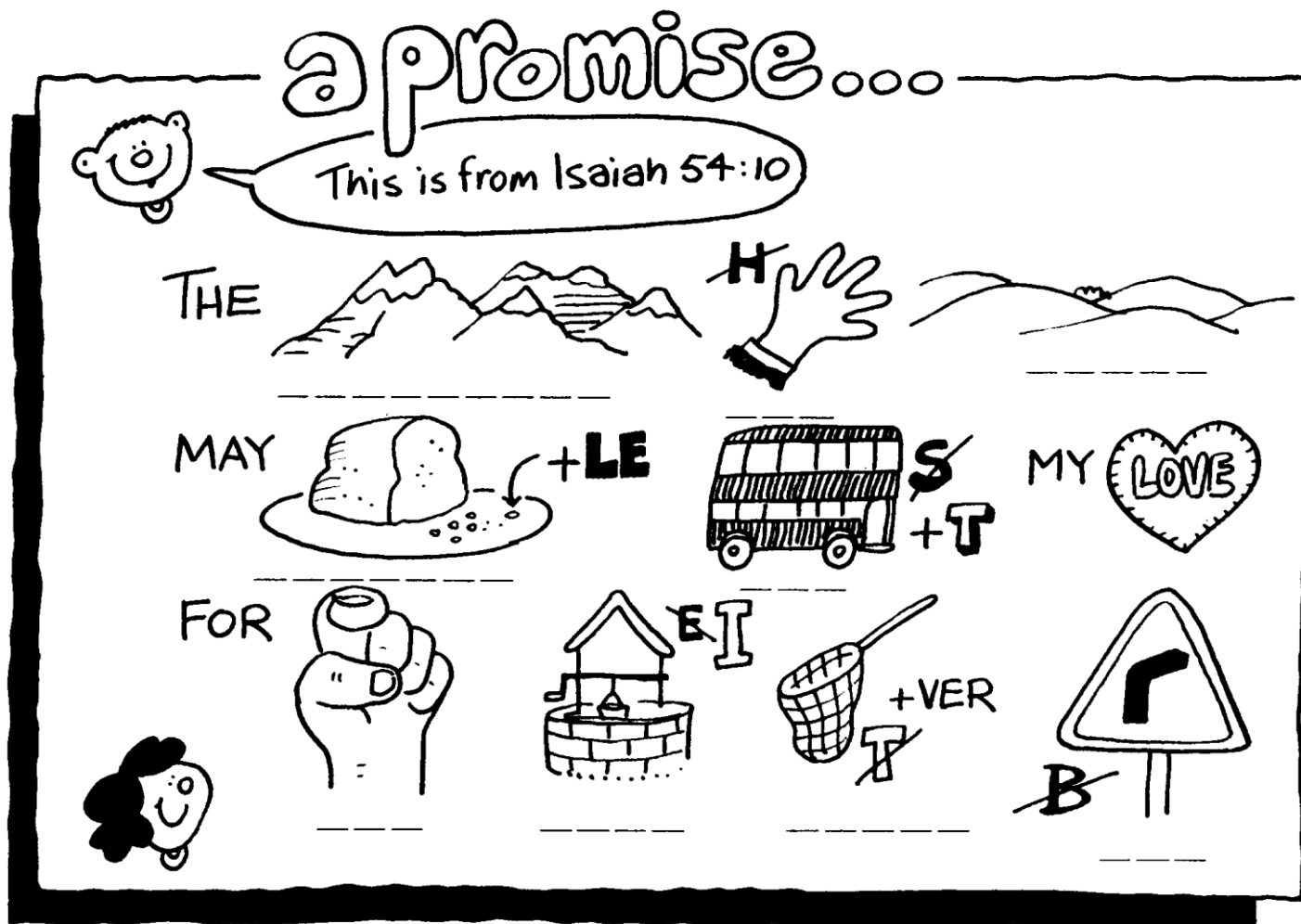
